3. Candidate must be bilingual. He/she must possess fluent knowledge of English (written and oral), as one or more European language (preferably French, Dutch, Swedish, Spanish or German)
4. Open-minded person with great interest in state-of-the-art technology and eager to learn, communicate and work in a global corporation.
