Sam Shakir is President, Operating Plant Services at Westinghouse Electric Company. In this role, he leads a global organization dedicated to maximizing the safety, performance and longevity of a worldwide nuclear fleet. He oversees Westinghouse's largest business unit delivering state-of-the-art solutions including Automation, Components, Engineering, Long-Term Operation, Parts, and the most comprehensive integrated Outage Services to plants around the world.

Mr. Shakir joined Westinghouse in 2021 as President of Environmental Services with responsibility for delivering specialized solutions to global commercial and government customers in decontamination and decommissioning, site clean-up and closure, and nuclear material management.

Mr. Shakir previously served as President and Chief Executive Officer of Orano USA, where he oversaw a variety of businesses supplying nuclear fuel materials; engineering; decontamination and decommissioning; and used nuclear fuel management technologies and services.

Prior to this role, he served in a series of increasingly responsible roles within the former AREVA Group with oversight for strategy, business and product development, and technical services for the nuclear industry.
