Emergencies

Emergencies: 9-1-1, x5911, (724) 722-5911

In the event you see a fire or smoke from a **Fire**:

- Activate the nearest wall mounted pull station
- Evacuate the building
- Call 9-1-1 or x5911 from any site phone or (724) 722-5911 from a cell phone
- Report the location and brief extent of the fire

In the event of a **Medical** situation:

- Security staff and trained First will respond and evaluate the situation
- If additional medical assistance is needed, Westmoreland County 9-1-1 will be contacted by site security
- **Note:** An ambulance will be called immediately upon notice of a patient with chest pains, shortness of breath or altered level of consciousness

Assembly Areas

Evacuation routes are posted throughout all floors of the building. Upon the sound of the alarm, immediate evacuation of the building is mandatory. Always use the stairs; do not use the elevators. Once outside, move away from the building to the designated assembly area in the lower parking lot area.

There are 2 primary assembly areas:

- Lower lot front of Bldg.
- Rear of Bldg. outside machine shop
