

Non-Disclosure Agreement for Visitors

In the course of your proposed visit, you may have access to certain information or technology that is not publicly available information concerning the design, construction, maintenance, repair, overhaul, refurbishment or operation of a nuclear reactor, including nuclear reactor development, production or use of the components within or attached directly to the reactor vessel, the equipment that controls the level of power in the core, and the equipment or components that normally contain or come in direct contact with or control the primary coolant of the reactor core, and technology for the development, production, or use of equipment or material especially designed or prepared for use with a nuclear reactor. Access to such information by persons who are not citizens or lawful permanent residents of the U.S. or transfer of such data to persons outside the U.S. comes within the scope of rules, codified at 10 CFR Part 810, promulgated by the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) concerning Assistance to Foreign Atomic Energy Activities. The information within the scope of such rules is referred to as "DOE-Controlled Information."

During your proposed visit, you may also have access to certain non-public information or technology concerning development, production, or use that comes within the scope of the Export Administration Regulations, codified at 15 CFR 730-799, promulgated by the U.S. Department of Commerce (DOC). Such information may include information controlled for nuclear nonproliferation such as zirconium, hafnium, information and control systems, turbine generators, condensers, other balance of plant equipment, and servicing equipment specially designed or intended for use with a nuclear power plant. The information within the scope of such rules is referred to as "DOC-Controlled Information."

Your proposed visit is subject to both 10 CFR Part 810 and the Export Administration Regulations.

In order to comply with U.S. Department of Energy regulations set forth at 10 CFR Part 810 and the U.S. Department of Commerce regulations set forth at 15 CFR 730-799, Westinghouse requests that you agree that:

- 1. You shall fully comply with those rules promulgated by the DOE concerning Assistance to Foreign Atomic Energy Activities set forth at 10 CFR Part 810, as amended from time to time. You agree that you shall not subsequently transfer any DOE- Controlled Information without prior written approvals of the U.S. Department of Energy and Westinghouse.
- 2. You shall fully comply with those rules promulgated by the DOC concerning the Export Administration Regulations set forth at 15 CFR Part 730-799, as amended from time to time. You agree that you shall not subsequently transfer any DOC- Controlled Information without prior written approvals of the U.S. Department of Commerce and Westinghouse.
