

Office for Nuclear Regulation (ONR) Site Report for Springfields Works

Report for period 1 April – 30 June 2022

Foreword

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1. Inspections

1.1. Dates of Inspection

The ONR site inspector made inspections on the following dates during the report period 1 April to 30 June 2022:

- 28 April 2022
- 5 May 2022
- 10-11 May 2022
- 19-20 April 2022
- 20-22 June 2022



2. Routine Matters

2.1. Inspections

Inspections are undertaken as part of the process for monitoring compliance with:

- the conditions attached by ONR to the nuclear site licence granted under the Nuclear Installations Act 1965 (NIA65) (as amended);
- the Energy Act 2013
- the Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974 (HSWA74); and
- regulations made under HSWA74, for example the lonising Radiations Regulations 2017 (IRR17) and the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999 (MHSWR99).

The inspections entail monitoring the licensee's actions on the site in relation to incidents, operations, maintenance, projects, modifications, safety case changes and any other matters that may affect safety. The licensee is required to make and implement adequate arrangements under the conditions attached to the licence in order to ensure legal compliance. Inspections seek to judge both the adequacy of these arrangements and their implementation.

In this period, routine inspections of Springfields Works covered the following:

- examination, maintenance, inspection and testing;
- management of operations including control and supervision;
- staff training, qualifications and experience;
- radioactive waste management;
- organisational changes;
- security
- safeguards

The site Annual Review took place on 21 June 2022. Overall ONR concurred with the Licensee's performance self-assessment presented to the regulators during the review.

2.2. Other Work

Springfields Works Covid arrangements have been suspended and the evolution of the pandemic situation continue to ensure that operational safety and emergency response capability is maintained.



ONR continue to work with Springfields Fuels Limited and their Parent Body Organisation, Westinghouse Electric Company LLC in exploring the regulation of future potential business opportunities at the Springfields Works site.

3. Non-Routine Matters

Licensees are required to have arrangements to respond to non-routine matters and events. ONR inspectors judge the adequacy of the licensee's response, including actions taken to implement any necessary improvements.

There were no such matters or events of significance during the period.

4. Regulatory Activity

ONR may issue formal documents to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements. Under nuclear site licence conditions, ONR issues regulatory documents, which either permit an activity or require some form of action to be taken; these are usually collectively termed 'Licence Instruments' (LIs) but can take other forms. In addition, inspectors may take a range of enforcement actions, to include issuing an Enforcement Notice.

 No LIs, Enforcement Notices or Enforcement letters were issued during this period.
